LANDING AND TIE DOWN FEES

Marlborough Aero Club will waive all landing and tie down fees from Friday 2nd Feb – Sunday 4th Feb for all aircraft registered for the competitions. There is limited space in the main hangar. If you would like to park your aircraft in the main hangar, please contact the Aero Club on 03 578 5073.

ACCOMMODATION

For those that wish to camp on the field beside their aircraft, this is free of charge and will be located adjacent to the Club rooms. Toilets, outside table/chairs, BBQ and running water are available.

For those staying in town, transport into Blenheim will be provided on Saturday evening as required.

COMPETITION

The competition safety briefing is mandatory for all competitors. Competitions will commence at 10.30am Saturday.

Note - OMAKA airfield will be in operation as per usual.

SUNDAY MORNING FLY-IN

No formal fly-in has been arranged this year, however something more informal may be worked out on the weekend. We will let you know on Saturday night if this is happening.

EVENING FUNCTION

If you wish to attend the evening function, please ensure you have booked and paid for your meal before the night to allow planning for catering. The bar (EFTPOS available) will be open from 4pm onwards for the purchase of drinks. Prize giving will be held around 8pm. There will also be several spot prizes in addition to the four main competition winners.

RESERVE DAY

In the event of the competition being cancelled on Saturday due to weather, Sunday has been set aside as the reserve day (the Sunday morning Fly-In will be cancelled). *Safety briefing will be at the earlier time of 0830, with competitions starting at 0930. This should give enough time for out of town pilots to get home in most cases.*

The evening function will still take place as planned on Saturday evening, however the prize giving will obviously be delayed until after the competitions on Sunday.

GENERAL

Depending on the wind and runway in use, there may be some distance to the competitions. Pedestrians and cars will not be allowed on the general airfield. Transport by van will be provided throughout the day for those needing to move around.

There will be catering outlets on the airfield from midday on Saturday, for you to be able to purchase food (BBQ sausages/bread roll etc), cold drinks and coffee.

There will be an official photographer on the day. Please note that less you request otherwise, images of you and/or your aircraft may be used in promotional material.

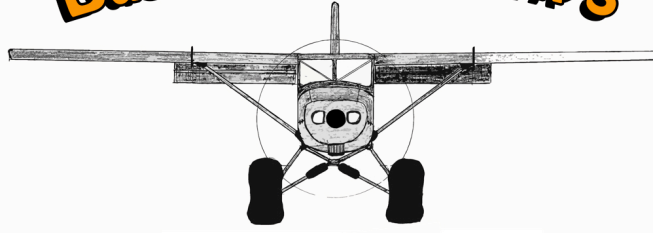
